<p>The main objective of the assignment is to assist countries in defining a replication/upscaling proposal for the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) based on a technical assessment of their existing demo project. The assignment will serve to help FSM, SPREP and UNDP access further funding for implementation once Pacific Adaptation to Climate Change (PACC) funds are used up by December 2013.</p> <p>Develop an up-scaling and replication proposal based on activities identified through consultation that can be implemented through additional funds</p> <p>Identify replication and up-scaling opportunities to extend the experiences of the ongoing demonstration activities in the pilot communities to additional areas and communities in the respective PACC project focus sectors (water, agriculture or coastal).
