Detailed description of project

On 11th October, 2010 a Memorandum of Understanding regarding the National Indicative Programme of 2011-13 for Egypt was signed between the EU and the Arab Republic. In this MoU, numerous proposals for new programmes have been agreed. One of these proposals is to implement a programme (with a potential budget of 10 million Euros) to develop aquaculture at Lake Manzala as an adaptation measure against sea-level rise and to address issues linked to wider climate change. An EC Framework contract has been awarded to international consultancy Nordic Consulting Group A/S (as part of the Euronet Consortium under the Framework Lot 6 – Environment) to develop an Identification Fiche that focuses on the need and focus of this "project idea". Preparation of the detailed project design shall follow later into 2011 (as a separate "Action Fiche") once agreement between the EU and the Egyptian Government can be reached on this project. Sustainable Seas Ltd were contracted to Lead a team of experts to provide the services required for the contract.

Type of services provided

The global objective of this consultancy mission is to assist the EU Delegation in Egypt in preparing a programme which develops aquaculture at Lake Manzalla in Egypt's Nile Delta region and at the same time acts as adaptation measure against sea-level rise. The consultancy mission has 2 key objectives:

- 1) to identify in detail the subject programme focusing on the analysis of the problem, the on-going and future complementary actions in this field and on the objectives, the expected results and sustainability of the proposed action.
- 2) to fully formulate the above identified programme focusing on its rationale, it's detailed description and all related implementation issues.

The identification and the formulation phases (set for this contract) was undertaken according to the EC's binding templates and procedures required for external actions. Thus the consultancy team (lead by Team Leader Jonathan McCue) produced an Identification fiche (IF) and the Action Fiche (AF) with the Technical and Administrative Provisions document (TAPs) and related annexes including a Logical Framework Matrix.
