<p>The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) is supporting the Government of Tuvalu in implementing a climate change adaptation project, funded by LDCF and AusAID, entitled “Increasing Resilience of Coastal Areas and Community Settlements to Climate Change in Tuvalu” that aims at addressing the first three (Coastal, Agriculture and Water) priorities out of the seven. The main objective of this Project is to increase the protection of livelihoods in coastal areas from dynamic risks related to climate change and climate variability in all inhabited islands of Tuvalu.</p> <p>Jonathan McCue was contracted through Sustainable Seas Ltd to provide a coastal engineer to provide expert services to develop practical coastal adaptation options for Nukulaelae and Nukufetau Atolls (Tuvalu) that can be implemented immediately.
