The Commonwealth Secretariat (ComSec), in partnership with the UN Environment Pro- gramme (UNEP) and other partners, is identifying two Commonwealth countries to assess their readiness to embark on the transition to a Sustainable Blue Economy (SBE). As part of UNEP's work to promote and enable a Sustainable Blue Economy (SBE), it has developed a prototype version of a Sustainable Blue Economy Transition Framework (SBE-TF), to support countries and stakeholders develop SBE policy pathways and implementation strategies at local, national and regional level. In order to test and refine the SBE-TF, UNEP has enlisted the Commonwealth Secretariat to pilot the SBE-TF in selected countries and regions through the Rapid Readiness Assessment (RRA) process. The primary objective of the RRA is to support participating countries in answering: "what desired national impacts will justify transitioning to a SBE?" and "what will need to be read- ied in order to implement the TF approach?"
